Passenger traffic to triple to 330 million annually by 2030

The plan aims to triple the aviation sector's economic contribution to USD\$74.6 billion by 2030

Air cargo volume is set to increase to 4.5 million tons from the current 0.8 million tons

> Two global long-haul connecting hubs are planned in Jeddah and Riyadh
